TOUR DESCRIPTIONS

TOUR #1 & #4 MONDAY & WEDNESDAY...*Rising Star Casino*...originally called “Grand Victoria Casino,” is located in Rising Sun, Indiana, only a short drive from where we are staying. Loaded with nearly 1,300 of the newest and hottest slots around plus a wide variety of your favorite table games, we have no doubt that you'll find the game you're looking for. All of this and more is easily accessible through the convenience of dockside gaming.

After winning in the casino, enjoy and indulge in one or more of our many fabulous dining options. From bacon and eggs, pies and pastries to steaks and seafood, the tremendous variety and quality of selections will have your taste buds begging for more!

Bus departs the Marriott on Monday at 2:00 PM and arrives before 3:00 PM at the casino. Bus will depart the casino at 9:00 PM and return to the Marriott by 10:00 PM. On Wednesday, the bus will leave at 9:00 AM and arrives before 10:00 AM at the casino. Bus will depart the casino at 3:00 PM and return to the Marriott by 4:00 PM. Upon arrival, you will receive your “play pass,” already loaded with \$5.00 in free slots play, and also a \$5.00 cash voucher redeemable at any cage or towards any dining option. These tours require names, addresses and dates of birth for all adults attending, sorry, no one under 21 years of age please. Submit required information on separate sheet of paper and enclose with your other papers. Cost-\$25.00 per person.

TOUR #2 TUESDAY...*King's Island*...is a 364-acre amusement park located 24 miles northeast of Cincinnati in Mason, Ohio. Opened in 1972 by Taft Broadcasting Company and now owned by Cedar Fair Entertainment Company, Kings Island is the most visited seasonal amusement park in the U.S. with an estimated 3.1 million visitors in 2010 (second overall in North America behind sister park Canada's Wonderland). It offers over 80 rides, shows, and attractions including 14 roller coasters and a 15-acre water park. Kings Island has won *Amusement Today's* Golden Ticket Award for having the "Best Kids' Area" in the world for ten consecutive years (2001–2010). Price includes use of the water park. There are ride restrictions for everyone under 48 inches tall.

This bus will depart the Marriott at 10:00 AM and arrive approximately by 11:00 AM. You'll be on your own until the departure time of 6:00 PM, and, depending on traffic, will arrive back at the Marriott around 7:00 PM. Cost-\$60.00 per person.

TOUR #3 TUESDAY...*Museum 3-in-1 trip*...The Cincinnati Museum Center at Union Terminal, originally Cincinnati Union Terminal, is a passenger railroad station in the Queensgate neighborhood of Cincinnati, Ohio. After the decline of railroad travel, most of the building was converted to other uses, and now houses museums, theaters, and a library. Cincinnati Museum Center is world renowned for operating the Cincinnati History Museum, the Museum of Natural History & Science, the Robert D. Lindner Family Omnimax Theater, the Cincinnati Historical Society Library, the Duke Energy Children's Museum and the Cincinnati Railroad Club. The Center caters to all ages from 2 to 102.

The Children's Museum is a “hands-on” working area that children from about age 12 on down will find exciting, educational and fun. There are plenty of sitting areas for moms and dads to watch their little ones enjoy and play.

The Museum of Natural History and Science takes visitors from the caves of the tri-state region to the Ice Age thousands of years ago, all while promoting the preservation of the environment. Check out Nature's Trading Post, which teaches children about responsible collecting and preservation of the environment; Clues Frozen in Time will take you back 19,000 years into the Ice Age of the Ohio Valley; and The Cavern: A World Without Light offers a simulated limestone cave modeled on caves found in the tri-state region of Ohio, Indiana and Kentucky and covers two levels and 500 feet of darkened passageways. A real “must see.”

The Cincinnati History Museum opened in 1990 and is one of the largest and most significant urban history museums in the country. The Cincinnati History Museum displays materials and related aspects of the history of Cincinnati and the surrounding region. Permanent exhibits include a re-creation of the Cincinnati Public Landing of the late 1850s, where you can step aboard a 94-foot side-wheel steamboat. The museum also has a large home-front exhibit on World War II and an actual 1940s streetcar. Visitors can also see a model of the city of Cincinnati from 1900s to 1940s with working trains and inclines, as well as interactive computer stations.

Also included in your ticket price is Omnimax Theatre show at 11 or 12 O'clock and entry to the periodic exhibition, scheduled in 2012 as “The Days of Pompeii.”

This bus will depart the Marriott at 9:30 AM. Anticipated arrival time is between 10:00 and 10:15 AM. Bus will depart the Museum at 4:00 PM, and is due back at the Marriott between 4:30 and 5:00 PM. Cost-\$55.00 per person.

TOUR #5 WEDNESDAY...*Peace Bell, BB Riverboat Lunch Cruise and Newport Aquarium*...The World Peace Bell is one of more than twenty Peace Bells around the World. It weighs 73,381 pounds and is 12 feet wide. From 2000 until 2006, it was the largest swinging bell in the World. It was dedicated on December 31, 1999, and was first swung as the year 2000 opened. Make sure you've got your earplugs with you as they ring the bell just for our group and it can be heard about 25 miles away. We'll re-board our bus and travel to the river where we'll enjoy...

OVER

...A break during our day on BB Riverboat lunch and cruise up the Ohio River! Climb aboard for a 2-hour cruise featuring games, entertainment, and a delicious buffet, featuring slow cooked sirloin beef tips, roast herb seasoned chicken, mashed potatoes, fresh green beans southern style, tossed salad with accoutrements, choice of dressings, rolls with butter, coffee or tea and our chef's choice of dessert. Upon our return and disembarkation, you're free to either visit the Newport Aquarium, included in your price or simply deduct \$15.00 and walk around the Levee and visit the various shops and kiosks.

The Newport Aquarium is an aquarium at Newport on the Levee. The aquarium has 70 exhibits and 14 galleries, including five seamless acrylic tunnels totaling over 200 feet in length. The aquarium showcases thousands of animals from around the world in a million gallons of water, including "Scooter" and "Sweet Pea," two of the few shark rays in captivity and the only breeding pair on display in the world. In 2009, the Aquarium received a baby shark ray from Taiwan, named Sunshine.

Newport on the Levee is located adjacent to the Purple People Bridge along the Ohio River and has a view of Cincinnati. The Levee is only one block away from the East Row Historic District and the Monmouth Street Historic District. It is named after the levee that it rests on. It includes various shops, restaurants, souvenir stores, a candy store, pubs and kiosks

Bus will leave the Marriott at 10:00 AM, arriving at the Peace Bell by 10:30. It will depart the Peace Bell by 11:15 AM and take you directly to the Riverboat. Bus will then transport all to Newport on the Levee, where the Aquarium is also located. Bus departs the Levee at 4:45 PM, returning to the Marriott by 5:30 PM

Cost for tour #4 is \$80.00 per adult and \$60.00 per child aged under 12 years. Please deduct \$15.00 if you decide **not** to visit the Newport Aquarium.

TOUR #6 THURSDAY...Shopping on your own at the Crestview Hills Town Center...in Northern Kentucky is anchored by Dillard's department store and Bed Bath & Beyond, as well as 65 other prime retailers and fine restaurants. Located on the former site of Crestview Hills Mall, this ground-up, redeveloped shopping & dining destination represents Jeffrey R. Anderson's third Lifestyle Center in Greater Cincinnati. We're currently working on having a wine-tasting during the day at Elk Creek Winery, which has a retail store in the mall. Bus will leave the Marriott at 10:00 AM and depart the Town Center at 3:30 PM. That will get you back to the Marriott at approximately 4:00 PM. Cost for this excursion is only \$25.00 per person.

TOUR #7 THURSDAY...Underground Railroad & Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Gardens...The National Underground Railroad Freedom Center is a museum in downtown Cincinnati, Ohio based on the history of the Underground Railroad. The Center also pays tribute to all efforts to "abolish human enslavement and secure freedom for all people." The Center offers lessons on the struggle for freedom in the past, in the present, and for the future as it attempts to challenge visitors to contemplate the meaning of freedom in their own lives. Its location recognizes the significant role of Cincinnati, where thousands of slaves escaped to freedom by crossing the Ohio River, in the history of the Underground Railroad.

The Cincinnati Zoo and Botanical Garden is the second-oldest zoo in the United States and is located in Cincinnati, Ohio. It opened in 1875, just 14 months after the Philadelphia Zoo on July 1, 1874. The Reptile House is the oldest zoo building in America, dating from 1875.

The Cincinnati Zoo is on 65.4 acres in the middle of the city, and since then it has acquired some of the surrounding blocks and several reserves in Cincinnati's outer suburbs. The Cincinnati Zoo was the home of Martha, the last living passenger pigeon, which died there in 1914. It was also home to the last living Carolina parakeet in 1918.

Rated by peer zoological parks as one of the best zoos in the nation, the Cincinnati Zoo continues to set the standard for conservation, education and preservation of wild animals and wild spaces. Over 1.2 million people visit the Zoo annually. The Zoo features more than 500 animal and 3,000 plant species, making it one of the largest Zoo collections in the country.

Bus will leave the Marriott at 9:00 AM and will depart the Zoo at 3:00 PM. Cost for this trip is \$55.00 per person.

1. Complete all information as requested on the form. Entrants may be called long distance **COLLECT** if information is not completed or correctly supplied.
2. Signature of your Financial Secretary is not required. To verify your status as a Knight of Columbus in good standing, you must present a valid and current Membership Card with your membership number clearly displayed, at the time of registration. To be in good standing for this tournament, your dues must be paid through March 31st of the current year.
3. Entry fee of \$160.00 includes 18 holes and riding cart for Thursday and Friday of the tournament and 3 evening social events.
4. Scramble fee of \$50.00 includes 18 holes and riding cart Wednesday.
