Selecting State Convention Delegates

The Council should select two (2) primary (voting) delegates and two (2) alternate delegates to attend the State Convention.

Delegates must be a Third-Degree Knight in good standing.

Any Third Degree Knight in good standing can attend the Convention business sessions as a "spectator." Spectators do not have to pay the registration fee to attend the Convention business sessions.

Any individual (3rd Degree, 1st Degree Knight, non-member, spouse, etc.) can attend all social events, banquets, and functions, if the individual pays the required registration fee.

Councils should strive to have both voting delegates attend the State Convention and encourage the two alternates and all other members to attend the State Convention.

Grand Knights and Council Recorders will get emails to confirm their delegates when they register. If you do not confirm your delegate prior to convention check in your delegate may not be allowed to vote. If your delegate registers and you do not get the email please contact State Technology Director Brett Cormier at tech@louisianakc.org


KC International Golf Tournament

PAST STATE DEPUTY AWARD

Do you know a Brother Knight who exhibits dedicated service to the Church, Country and Columbianism? If so, consider nominating him for the Past State Deputy Award.

The Award Criteria is as follows:

1. Any Louisiana Knight of Columbus member in good standing at the time of the exemplary service. If

- awarded posthumously, or at some length of time after the exemplary service, nominee must have been in good standing at the time of death or now, if still living.
- 2. Any Louisiana Knight who has exemplified loyal service to the Church, responsible citizenship to the country and outstanding dedication to the principles of Columbianism.
- 3. Past State Deputies are not eligible for this award.

As we are approaching the second half of the fraternal year, many of the local Special Olympics events (mostly Track & Field) will be taking place. SAFE ENVIRONMENT COMPLIANCE

Is your Council Safe Environment Compliant? The Grand Knight, Program Director, Family Director and Community Director are required to take Safe Environment training. To check if your Council is compliant, the Grand Knight or Financial Secretary should log in to Officers Online on the Supreme Website. Scroll down to the bottom third of the page and click on Reports. Run the Safe Environment Member Status report. Open the report and check to see if all required members are compliant. If the report does not show the four required roles, you need to re-appoint the missing positions.

To re-appoint any open position, go to Officers Online and update Form 365. Clickhere to go to the Fraternal Video Library. Scroll down to Forms, then click on Forms 185, 186, & 365 Online Submission Training.

The deadline to receive credit for the State Deputy Award has been extended to May 31, 3024. With this extended deadline, there is no reason every Council should not be compliant.
