

Louisiana Right to Life

Planned Parenthood Report Shows Abortion Up, Revenue at Highest Recorded Level

Planned Parenthood's <u>2015-16 annual report</u> is finally out and shows the nation's largest abortion provider saw fewer patients but performed more abortions than a year earlier. Revenues, including taxpayer funding, are also up from fiscal year 2014-15, while non-abortion services, such as cancer screenings, declined.

Abortion numbers have been declining nationwide in recent years, but at Planned Parenthood, those numbers are back up. In 2015-16 Planned Parenthood performed 328,348 abortions, up from 323,999 abortions a year earlier.



Is this what is in store for Louisiana if Planned Parenthood is able to get approval to do abortions at its New Orleans location?

Planned Parenthood affiliates reported seeing 2.4 million patients in 2015-16, while they saw 2.5 million in 2014-15. The organization received \$554.6 million in taxpayer funding in 2015-16, up from \$553.7 million a year earlier. Planned Parenthood's total revenue for 2015-16 was \$1,354 million, up from \$1,296.1 million in 2014-15 and the highest the group has ever recorded.

In 2015-16, PP performed

328,348
abortions nationally.

The population of
Orleans Parish - 343,829
East Baton Rouge Parish - 440,171

At the same time abortion and revenue was on the rise:

Bossier and Caddo Parishes - 371,948

- Prenatal services dropped from 17,419 in 2014-15 to 9,419 just one year later.
- Cancer screening and prevention services dropped from 682,208 in 2014-15 to 665,234 just one year later.
- Contraception services dropped from 2,945,059 in 2014-15 to 2,808,815 just a year later.

While adoption referrals increased in 2015-16 (from 2,024 to 2,889), they accounted for just 0.8% of Planned Parenthood's pregnancy services. Prenatal care accounted for just 3% of the pregnancy services provided, while abortion accounted for 96%.

<u>The Susan B. Anthony List</u> compared Planned Parenthood's annual reports for the past five years (2011-2016) and found:

- Planned Parenthood's total services are down nearly 13%.
- Unique patients have dropped by 600,000 a 20% decline.
- Total cancer screening and prevention services, breast exams, and pap tests all dropped by nearly 50%.
- Contraceptive services are down 18%.
- Planned Parenthood performed approximately 145 abortions (1,641,130) for every one adoption referral (11,290)

VICTORY CELEBRATED! Louisiana Right to Life

Victory Celebration is Last Event at Bossier Address

About 50 people gathered under the hot sun Saturday to celebrate the closure of the Bossier City Medical Suite, one of two abortion facilities in North Louisiana.

The celebration was organized by the Shreveport-Bossier 40 Days for Life group. Chris Davis, who leads the Shreveport-Bossier group, called it the "Last Event Ever" they would hold on the sidewalk in front of the facility at 1505 Doctors Drive, where sidewalk counselors and prayer warriors have been a fixture for many years.

"The closing of the abortion facility in Bossier is without a doubt the greatest thing to happen to the Shreveport-Bossier pro-life community ever!" Davis said. "Tremendous gratitude goes out to everyone who has taken part in this effort in every way. Special thanks go out to all of the sidewalk ministries and pregnancy resource centers throughout our area.

"Our PRCs now outnumber abortion facilities at least four to one. When combined with all of the pro-life groups in our area, we outnumber them a dozen or more to one!"

40 Days for Life President Shawn Carney and Lauren Muzyka, executive director of Sidewalk Advocates for Life, spoke at the celebration.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

We continue to assist a local safe house, the <u>Free Indeed Home</u>, where girls ages 12-17 who have been sex trafficked can come for healing.

If you or your group would like to participate in the collection of much-needed items, please contact the Respect Life Office at respectlife@arch-no.org to facilitation this. No drop-offs can be accepted.

The following items are needed:

- Cash or gift cards for grocery/big box stores
- Canned vegetables, flour, sugar, corn meal, seasoning, cooking oil, pasta, rice, cereals, canned meats, boxed cake mix, pudding
- Paper towel, toilet paper, paper napkins

- Comet Cleanser, Clorox Clean-up, dish detergent, disinfectant spray, multi-surface cleaner, baking soda, floor wax for hardwood floors, laundry detergent
- Feminine products
- Board games, puzzles, craft items
- Copy paper (cheapest kind), pens, pencils, crayons, color pencils, markers, dry eraser markers, loose leaf paper, notebooks, binders, printer ink for an HP 950 and 951, batteries (all sizes, primarily AA and AAA).

REQUEST FOR HELP TO END ABORTION

This is a request from Archbishop Aymond: With the recent closures of facilities in Bossier City and Metairie, there are three remaining abortion clinics operating in the state of Louisiana, one within the city of New Orleans — Woman's Health Care Center on General Pershing Street. On any Tuesday through Friday mornings, there are upwards of 25 women waiting in line to enter the clinic, while there may be at most only one sidewalk counselor present to offer support.

If you are interested in becoming a sidewalk counselor at the General Pershing Street abortion facility, please contact the Archdiocesan Respect Life Office at 504-286-1119 or respectlife@arch-no.org. The need is urgent; training and ongoing support will be provided.

This is a note from Wilson, veteran sidewalk counselor who is at General Pershing most weekdays: "Like I have done in the past at Ridgelake, if anyone wishes to go out to the General Pershing mill at anytime after we leave to pray, witness, or whatever on a regular schedule, I will be glad to come out & help them get started."



HELP NEEDED TO GET ULTRASOUND FOR WOMAN'S NEW LIFE CENTER

The Woman's New Life Center is located directly adjacent to the Delta abortion mill in Baton Rouge. The ability to show pregnant women their child in the womb has a huge influence on their decision to not have an abortion. Therefore, this is a critical part of their pro-life work.

However, the machine is outdated and it is unable to provide clients with clear and accurate pictures of the baby.

Council 8147 in Gonzales (GK Ralph Roger) will participate in the Ultrasound Initiative to obtain the ultrasound machine. They are looking for additional councils to pledge \$1,000 or more to help raise the required amount of money. Their goal is to raise, \$20,000.

Through her efforts and so many that have served through Community Center for Life, we have been able to serve and educate thousands of women in our community and the surrounding areas.

Would your organization be willing to partner with us in providing funding to acquire a new ultrasound machine? An **ultrasound machine** provides so much more than a picture. It provides pertinent medical information. It allows an expectant mother, especially one who has many stresses such as homelessness, toxic family and/or partner relationships, etc, to be able to have some reassurance that the life inside of her is thriving. We want to be able to continue to provide that reassurance.

The cost of a new machine is estimated to be around \$33,500. This cost would include the machine, the tools associated with operating the machine, installation, training on use and also shipping.

Human trafficking is not just an issue in foreign countries. It's a real issue across America and, now, throughout our own State.

According to national statistics, one of the busiest trafficking corridors stretches from Houston to New Orleans. The victims ultimately reach virtually every corner of Louisiana. The average age of a trafficking victim is 13.

These children come from every walk of life – some abducted, others lured by traffickers. They are then transported to other states where they are forced to perform sexual acts, sometimes as often as 20 times a day. The impact on trafficked children is devastating.

The victims of human trafficking are nothing more than income-producing property for their handlers. They have each been robbed of their childhood. There is no joy in their lives.

Fr. Jeff Bayhi is leading an effort to provide a secure home for trafficking victims to recover from their ordeal (see this <u>news story</u>). They need your support! SIX THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT PLANNED PARENTHOOD'S LATEST REPORT Jeanne Mancini, President, March for Life

Planned Parenthood typically releases its annual report in December or January each year, but only made their latest report, for 2015-2016, available earlier this week, six months late. Could it be that they sought to delay or hide the truth about the "services" they provide?

As Congress considers healthcare reform legislation that would redirect the federal funding Planned Parenthood currently receives to Federally Qualified Health Centers, this latest report from the nation's largest abortion provider gives information that prolife Americans need to know.

Here are six points from Planned Parenthood's latest annual report:

- 1. In the last year,* Planned Parenthood performed 328,348 abortions. This is an increase of over 4,300 more abortions from the prior year. Note that the national number of abortions decreased during this time. Planned Parenthood is increasing its market value for abortions.
- 2. Total revenue (\$1.354 billion) and government funding (\$554.6 million) in 2016 are the highest they have been for Planned Parenthood.
- 3. Planned Parenthood made more than \$77 million in profit. This is an increase of \$19 million more than the year prior. Keep in mind that Planned Parenthood is a non-profit organization. Additionally, Planned Parenthood invests heavily in electing abortion advocates. A recent article revealed that Planned Parenthood's political arms spent over \$38 million in election funding between 2012 and 2016.
- 4. Non-reproductive health care services have greatly decreased. Cancer screenings have dropped by half since 2011, abortions now outnumber basic breast exams for the first time in its history.
- The number of patients and prenatal services continues to decrease. Prenatal services have dropped by almost half since last year alone, and the number of patients is down by four percent.
- 6. They falsely claim that the Center for Medical Progress Video footage containing damning evidence of Planned Parenthood's involvement in the trafficking of baby parts was "heavily edited" and "widely discredited". However, a forensic analysis and congressional investigation have disproven these erroneous talking points. Read more HERE.

As you can see abortion and revenue numbers continue to go up, and women's health services continue to decrease, and yet government funding has increased over the past year.

LOUISIANA ABORTION RATE DROPS 4% IN 2016 Louisiana Right to Life

The number of abortions in Louisiana decreased by 4 percent from 2015 to 2016, according to preliminary figures provided to Louisiana Right to

Life recently by the Department of Health.


It was the second straight year we saw a decline in the number of unborn babies killed by abortion in our state.

There were 8,972 abortions performed in Louisiana in 2016, down from 9,362 abortions reported in 2015 and 10,211 abortions reported in 2014. The number of abortions performed in the state had increased steadily from 2008-2014 as population numbers returned to pre-Katrina levels.

Even though abortion numbers are going down, there are still, on average, 25 abortions performed each day in Louisiana. Louisiana Right to Life will continue working hard to reduce these numbers until every baby is saved.

SOME QUICK FACTS ABOUT THE 2016 STATISTICS:

- There were 8,972 abortions performed. That means there were, on average, 25 abortions per day.
- Women categorized as "non-white" accounted for 70% of abortions performed.
- 85% of women who had abortions were unmarried.
- Nearly 70% of babies were aborted within eight weeks of pregnancy.
- 34 girls under 15 had abortions, and another 811 were between 15-19.

QUOTES OF THE MONTH

The Catechism of the Catholic Church on Abortion:

2271 Since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion, that is to say, abortion willed either as an end or a means, is gravely contrary to the moral law:

You shall not kill the embryo by abortion and shall not cause the newborn to perish (Didache).

God, the Lord of life, has entrusted to men the noble mission of safeguarding life, and men must carry it out in a manner worthy of themselves. Life must be protected with the utmost care from the moment of conception: abortion and infanticide are abominable crimes (GS 51 3).

2272 Formal cooperation in an abortion constitutes a grave offense. The Church attaches the canonical penalty of excommunication to this crime against human life. "A person who procures a completed abortion incurs excommunication latae sententiae," "by the very commission of the offense," and subject to the conditions provided by Canon Law. The Church does not thereby intend to restrict the scope of mercy. Rather, she makes clear the gravity of the crime committed, the irreparable harm done to the innocent who is put to death, as well as to the parents and the whole of society.
