# CHANGES AT BATON ROUGE ABORTION MILL

We were told that Dr. Rashonda Dean had been fired, and we have learned that someone else had been hired (see below). On their first week after the change, they worked on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. If anyone can come out any of those days it would be appreciated. Update: They are now on Mondays as well.

The new doctor is James C. Degueurce III. He is associated with the Hope Medical Group for Women (click here for more information). He graduated from Louisiana State University School of Medicine on June 3, 1972. He was formerly at Abortion Assistance, a.k.a. Bossier City Medical Suite in Bossier City. He left when it closed on March 30, 2017. He is also a former abortionist at Causeway Medical Suite (click here for more information).

"Death-scorts" are still being used at Delta to prevent pregnant women from interacting with the sidewalk counselors. However, some saves are being documented because some women are making their way to the Woman's New Life Center located directly adjacent to Delta. Also, regular faithful prayer warriors, counselors and always faithful Pontachoula Demon Busters were out on front lines, including prayer warriors from Bethany Prayer Center.

# **COUNCIL MAKES DONATION TO WNLC**

The Woman's New Life Center is a non-profit professional counseling center and medical clinic serving women and families struggling with unplanned pregnancies, as well as those dealing with a past abortion. They also offer free pregnancy tests and ultrasounds. Their mission is to promote the dignity of women, the sacredness of sexuality, and the sanctity of life.

# BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN WAS A BIG SUCCESS

The Dignity of Life ministry at St. Aloysius parish and KC Council 3743 conducted a Baby Bottle Campaign to raise money for the Pregnancy Problem Center (PPC) in Baton Rouge that provides a variety of services to pregnant women who are at high risk for an abortion. The center has been serving women in Baton Rouge for over 36 years now. The campaign (that took place in January) raised \$10,000 and money is still coming in!

In the past year, the PPC has obtained a new ultrasound machine so that mothers can see their babies in their womb. They have also expanded educational services to aid women in crisis pregnancies. The center also has a "Mom and Me" shop to help clothe and feed both moms and babies. They have also established an Earn and Learn program. All of these support programs requires substantial funds, and the Baby Bottle Campaign at St. Aloysius will provide those much needed funds.

### NEW ULTRASOUND DELIVERED TO CENTER

St. Mark's Council 8147 in Gonzales led a successful effort to obtain a new ultrasound machine for the Woman's New Life Center in Baton Rouge. Ultrasound machines are an essential tool in helping mothers with a crisis pregnancy to choose life.

This machine was obtained through the Knights of Columbus Ultrasound Initiative. The council was able to raise the necessary funds with help from several local KC councils. We want to particularly thank Baton Rouge Council 9016 that made the largest single contribution to this effort.

On March 16<sup>th</sup>, the council paid a visit to the center to see the new machine now that it is in active use. The staff is very impressed with the machine's features and ease of use. The new software allows networking capabilities and provides crisp imaging of babies in the womb. Everyone is very excited with this new machine.

The Community Center for Life in Gretna is there, we have the \$16,800 needed to obtian an ultrasound machine through the Knights of Columbus Ultrasound Initiative. I wonder if ultrasound machines use supplies like ink or paper. If so, then we can get them going in style. Last month, I submitted the forms to Supreme, and I was more excited than when buying a house or new car. This project has strengthened my faith in the Lord's generosity. When we started the process, I had an idea about how to get things moving but with no end game.

I am not clear on the circumstances that led to the merger of two Baton Rouge parishes and related merger of two KC councils. However, I know that the generosity of brother knights of Council 9016 made it possible to provide a life-saving ultrasound machine much sooner than I would ever have imagined. Of course, other councils donated money for the materials allowing me to sell the pro-life angels so that we could honestly say that "all the money is going to the ultrasound machine." I thank the Lord for the privilege to call you my brothers.

I am awed by the strength, pro-life dedication, and generosity of the donors. One person from our church bought a garden angel for their home but gave it to her dad because it would have a greater visibility given the higher traffic volume there. The strength of God's love became apparent when he offered to pay most of the cost for someone else to have one. This is a modern "Widow's Might."

We are waiting on Supreme to provide the matching funds for the ultrasound machine. When that happens, I will visit the center to give them the checks. I will share photos as soon as possible.

We are also having our annual Access Pregnancy Center Baby Bottle Campaign starting at Infant Jesus of Prague on June 9-10<sup>th</sup> at all masses and June 23-24<sup>th</sup> at St. Martha, all masses as well.

Finally, on Saturday morning (at 7:30 set-up time) on April 7th at shelter #10 in Audubon Park, the Women's New Life Center is having their annual Born to Run fun run. We have been gradually building up our donation of Draft Root Beer to this year's 5 KEGS (25 gallons). I expect the New Orleans Ice Cream Company will match us with a donation of 5 large tubs of their delicious ice cream.

For the last couple of years I have been in complete awe of all our councils that come to donate food and drinks for the runners. Last year, I sent in some photos of these councils, and we need to identify the booths to let everyone know that: WE ARE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS AND WE ARE PRO-LIFE. 



# QUOTE OF THE MONTH

Myth: "High Court Rules Abortions Legal the First 3 Months."

Fact: Abortion is legal through all 9 months of pregnancy. In *Roe v. Wade*, the Supreme Court ruled that abortion may not be restricted at all in the first trimester; in the second trimester abortion may be regulated only for the mother's health. After "viability," abortion may be prohibited except where necessary to preserve the mother's health.

Roe's companion case, Doe v. Bolton, defined maternal "health" as: "all factors—physical, emotional, psychological, familial, and the woman's age—relevant to the well-being of the patient."

Thus, abortion is legal—and cannot be prohibited—in the 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, or 9<sup>th</sup> months of pregnancy if any of these reasons is involved.


Fr. Champagne is a famous retreat master who is best known for his "mercy mobile." It was filmed by the Diocese of Lafayette and is available here.




# PRO-LIFE DVD RECOMMENDATION


